
Coastal Adventures & Castaways Program



The Coastal Adventures Program is designed for the older scout who has attended camp many times in the past. It is a busy week filled with fun, adventure and challenges.

Don't plan on seeing too much of your older Scouts during the week!

Scouts must be 14 years old or have completed the 8th grade by camp, be classified as a swimmer and hold 1st Class rank.

The program will run all day and will include sailing, sea kayaking, survival skills, shooting sports, orienteering skills, leave-no-trace camping skills, COPE/climbing, cycling, fishing and for those brave souls, an intense off-camp overnight outdoor skills trip (*Castaways*).

During the week scouts will have the opportunity to work on Camping, Cooking, Small Boat Sailing, Motorboating & Fishing Merit Badges. Scouts registering for this program will be given a weekly detailed schedule of events upon arrival at camp.

Scouts participating in the *Castaways* overnighter should bring a sleeping bag, water bottle, rope, and sleeping pad (equipment associated with an overnight high adventure program).

There is a \$10.00 equipment fee associated with this program. Scouts who complete the total program will receive a *Coastal Adventures Program Base Camp* patch.
