

## 2010 COPE & Climbing Program

### COPE & Climbing Merit Badge

Project COPE (Challenging Outdoor Personal Experience) is a great leadership training opportunity for your older scouts. Three hours each day are devoted to developing the skills of team work, problem solving, communications, trust, initiative, and “thinking outside the box”. Participants will hone these skills on our “low and high” challenge courses and 100 yard zip line.

**COPE** is limited to scouts who are at least 14 by the start of camp. **Interested adult leaders and Venture Crew members are encouraged to participate and will qualify for BSA COPE Instructor upon successful completion of the program.** There is a \$20.00 fee for COPE.

**Climbing Merit Badge** is an excellent introduction to the sport of climbing. Participants will meet 2 hours each day. They will learn the skills and safety procedures to successfully complete the merit badge including three different surface climbs, belaying, and repelling on our 40 ft tower. There is a \$10.00 fee.

### Climbing After Dark

On Tuesday evening, from 8:30PM until 11:00PM the lighted Climbing Tower will be open for scouts who would like to take on the challenging of climbing at night. Space is limited so sign up early. There is a \$3.00 fee associated with the program. Tickets can be purchased at the trading post.

### Ziping-In-the-Dark

Zip-the-line on Thursday night at 8:30 PM. Scouts must be 14 by the start of camp to participate. There is a \$3.00 fee associated with this program. Tickets can be purchased at the trading post. There's limited space so get your ticket early.
