

2010 Health & Safety Program

The Health & Safety Program Area offers First Aid, Emergency Preparedness, and Fire Safety Merit Badges.

Fire Safety involves an off-site visit to a local fire station.

First Aid Merit Badge is available for 2nd Class Scouts and above. Scouts must bring material from home to make a home-made 1st Aid kit.

Scouts must first have 1st Aid MB before arriving at camp to take Emergency Preparedness Merit Badge.

American Red Cross 1st Aid & AED/CPR Certification is available from 3:00-5:00 PM for scouts (15+ years old) and adults. Cost is \$17.50 to cover Red Cross trained cards & material.

American Red Cross Wilderness First Aid will be offered for leaders involved in High Adventure programs (required training). The class will meet each day from 9:00am until 5:00pm. Cost is \$50.00 for Red Cross trained card and required training materials.

Health & Safety classes are held at the reception center and tee-pee area.
