



Camp Bonner Leave No Trace Award

1. Recite and explain in your own words the seven principles of Leave No Trace. Discuss these principles with your counselor, and discuss how an ethical guideline differs from a rule.
2. Add a principle to Leave No Trace and explain why you feel this principle should be added.
3. Explain why practicing Leave No Trace principles are important to Camp Bonner. Give examples of times you have had your experience at camp impacted by others following or disregarding the principles of Leave No Trace.
4. Explain the differences in Leave No Trace principles as they relate to pristine wilderness and established campgrounds. Discuss the consequences of not practicing Leave No Trace principles in both wilderness areas and established campgrounds (such as Camp Bonner).
5. Participate in a Leave No Trace service project of at least one hour approved by your counselor that reduces or rehabilitates recreational impacts at Camp Bonner. Discuss which recreational impacts were involved with the project.
6. Teach a Leave No Trace related skill to your troop, patrol, or other interested group.
